CABIN FEATURES

LAUNCH BOATS

Four auxiliary aluminum launch boats equipped with four-stroke low emission engines; constant radio communication with the main vessel. Each boat has a capacity of 8 passengers.





INTERCONNECTING SUITES

Two sets of two interconnecting suites for families. For the ultimate luxury, passengers may select a pair of interconnecting suites, either for families or with one suite configured as a private living room, the other a master bedroom, plus his-and-hers bathrooms.

SAFETY
